- Payment made in advance for any meals booked (if no payment is received we cannot provide a meal)
- If a meal hasn't been ordered you will need to provide a packed lunch
- Meals cost £2.25 please make cheques payable to 'NCC All Saints CEVA Primary School.



Communication

It is important to keep lines of communication open at all times. Please make sure the school office has up to date contact details, should the need arise for school to contact you.

For Safeguarding purposes, if there is a change to who collects your child at the end of the day, please let the office know. We are sure you can appreciate, for the safety of your child; teachers cannot let a pupil go home with someone different without being informed beforehand. This also applies to the normal Bus route and After School Club at the Nursery and Child Care Centre.

If your child is ill, please call the school office before 8.45. Please do not send emails to the school office as they are not always seen by this time.

Staff are always happy to speak with parents regarding any concerns or messages that need to be passed on. For non emergencies, the best time is at the end of the day, due to teachers getting their classes ready for lessons in the morning. A member of the Senior Management Team is always on the front gate in the mornings, should you need to pass on any information.

For more in depth conversations, please arrange a time to meet with your child's class teacher in the first instance. If you need to discuss further or are not satisfied with the outcome, please arrange an appointment via the school office to speak to Miss Tobin or Mr Isherwood.

We welcome our new Reception children & their families on Monday 10th September.

- From the 10 - 14th Sept (Week 1) Mrs Bateman or Mrs Cairns will welcome your children at the gate from 8.30 - 8.45. Children will need to be picked up at 11.45.
- Week 2: Mrs Bateman or Mrs Cairns will greet your children at the school gate from 8.30 - 8.45. Children will stay for lunch (Please see your Key Stage Newsletter) and will finish their day at 12.45.
- 24th Sept (Week 3) Children start full time and finish the school day at 3pm.
